




## Pronouns & Prepositions English Homework


**Prepositions** are words that shows a relationship between a noun (or pronoun) and another word in a sentence.



UP



BESIDE



ABOVE



BETWEEN



IN FRONT OF

Remember that prepositions also show **time relationships**.  
These include during, before and after.

Ryan is an excellent student. Ryan has a younger sister.

We can change this to:

Ryan is an excellent student. **He** has a younger sister.


